

SCHOOL MEAL CHARGING POLICY

The goal of the school breakfast and lunch program is to provide healthy meals for all students each day. The Agawam Public Schools will not deny students a meal. Students may receive an alternative meal and milk option should the cost of the meal not be accounted for in accordance with this policy. Free and Reduced Applications are always available throughout the year to help families in need.

Should a student forget their lunch money, the student will be fed a regular school lunch option that day, their account will be billed accordingly, and a notification will be sent home with the student.

If a student has not paid for three (3) meals or more, parents/guardians will be notified by the Food Service Director. If payment is not received after initial contact, the student must either bring a lunch from home or the student will be provided with an alternate meal and milk.
