

MEDICAL CONDITIONS

Any student who has a physical, emotional, or medical problem, which could affect the student's educational progress, **must** have on file in the principal's and/or nurse's office in the student's school a document from the student's attending physician explaining the nature of the student's condition and any limitations that can/may affect the student's education. The student and the attending physician in cooperation with the school staff will regularly develop an appropriate educational plan while the student is attending school or if it is agreed that the student should no longer attend school regularly.

If the student's attending physician or other medical professional determines that a student should no longer attend school regularly because of a communicable disease pursuant to 105 CMR 300 physical, emotional, or medical problem, a note from the student's physician **is required** in order for the student to return to school. Every effort will be made to see that the educational program of the student is disrupted as little as possible, that health counseling services, as well as instruction are offered, that return to school is encouraged, and that every opportunity to complete the school year is provided.
