Late last night, I was informed that a family member of one of the high school students had flu-like symptoms and was reporting to his physician. There are no siblings in any of the Agawam schools. In an abundance of caution, the high school will be closed today so that custodians could perform a thorough and deep cleaning and disinfecting of the facility. This cleaning involves scrubbing & disinfecting all hard surfaces and touch points such as door knobs, push bars, etc. This cleaning started Thursday night and will continue today and into the weekend.

Please rest assured that all precautions are being followed in each of our schools. In addition, the bus company is thoroughly cleaning all busses on a daily basis.

As you are aware, the Coronavirus is changing how we do business on a daily basis. I urge you all to take precautions to keep yourselves healthy.

I continue to work with our health agent from the town and follow the guidelines that have been set by the state. There is a statewide conference call for superintendents this morning with the Commissioner of Education. I expect to have more information to share after that call. I will keep you posted on the latest developments as information comes forth.
