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Graduation Requirements

(to receive an Agawam Adult Education diploma)

All students must take and pass (with a grade no lower than a 65%) the following required courses:

- **4 semesters of English**
 - **3 semesters of Math**
 - **2 semesters of Science**
 - **2 semesters of Social Studies (1 must be U.S. History)**
 - **1 semester of Technology Education**
 - **Students must also pass the English, Math, and Science MCAS.**
 - **Without MCAS, a Certificate of Attainment is awarded upon successful completion of all required course work.**
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- ❖ **Each class meets once a week for 10 weeks; each meeting time will be 3 hours, totaling 30 instructional hours per course.**
 - ❖ **The Adult Education semesters run from September to December, and from January to April.**
 - ❖ **Those interested in working toward an Agawam Evening High School diploma or Certificate of Attainment must call ahead of time to schedule an appointment to enroll.**

Paperwork required:

 - **Transcript of any course work completed**
 - **Any MCAS scores since grade 9**
 - **Letter of withdrawal from previously attended high school**
 - **SASID number**
 - ❖ **Students are also allowed to earn credits towards their Adult Education diploma by taking courses through the Agawam Summer School.**
 - ❖ **Consideration will be given to courses completed and successfully passed at an accredited high school towards the Agawam Adult Education diploma.**
