Update re: New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC) Accreditation

Agawam High School’s faculty members have completed a yearlong, extensive NEASC self-study reviewing all educational programs, processes, systems, and practices to determine the degree to which the school aligns with rigorous Standards. They are to be commended for their unwavering efforts preparing seven Standards reports, establishing “Critical Strengths and Needs,” and determining a targeted two- and five-year Strategic Plan.

One of the major requirements for NEASC membership is that the entire school be evaluated following this self-study. This evaluation is conducted by a visiting team of professional educators, sent by the Committee, who review the comprehensive materials prepared by the faculty in the self-assessment, visit classes, and talk with students, teachers, administrators, parents, and community members during their four-day visit to the school. We look forward to this formal evaluation on Sunday, September 29, through Wednesday, October 2, 2019.

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
