Following the completion of a year-long NEASC Self-Study, a site visit was conducted at Agawam High School on September 29-October 2, 2019. The Visiting Team assessed the quality of teaching and learning in terms of the school's stated mission and the Committee's seven Standards for Accreditation. A Decennial Report of the Visiting Team has been received and is attached for your review.

The Decennial Report has the following format:

- Introduction
- School and Community Summary
- Seven chapters organized by Standards
- Three components per chapter
 - Conclusions
 - Commendations
 - Recommendations
- Follow-up responsibilities

For your convenience, also attached are documents summarizing the recommendations and commendations in an abridged format. We are awaiting accreditation status at this time, and a Follow-up Committee is being formed to address the recommendations and to establish a plan and timeline for completion.

The New England Association of Schools and Colleges is a voluntary membership organization of more than 2,000 public schools, colleges, and universities, independent schools, and vocational, technical, and career institutions. Of these, over 630 secondary schools have been accredited through this continued process of evaluation. Agawam High School has proudly maintained accreditation since 1944.
